



IN HOME THERAPY SERVICES SUPERVISOR COLUMBIA FAMILY SERVICES CLINIC (COLUMBIA, SC)

Full time position based out of Columbia, SC, and will report to the Sr. Director of Community-Based Services or designee. The South Carolina Youth Advocate Program (SCYAP) is seeking an In Home Therapy Supervisor to provide oversight and clinical supervision for a team of therapists providing mental health services to children, adolescents, and their families. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: providing intake services for In Home Mental Services; ensuring that staff meet the professional qualifications and training requirements, as required by licensing, certification, funding, and regulatory entities; providing support and monitoring of assessment services provided by program staff; reviewing clinical documentation to ensure appropriate services delivery compliant with managed care and private insurance standards, contractual standards, Medicaid standards, accreditation and certification standards, and organizational and program specific policies and procedures; assisting in the prudent and effective financial management of services/programs, such as reviewing payroll for In Home Mental Health Services, acting as liaison between community-based services and billing/HR departments, negotiating contracts, etc.; assisting in the development and utilization of data management systems to improve tracking of referrals for services, maximization of contracts, and overall management of a pool of therapists; aiding in strategic planning and implementation of program/service expansion and growth initiatives.

Minimum qualifications: Master's degree in the social services field and experience in the area of children/youth services, child welfare, and or juvenile/justice. Master's level licensure required. Licensed Independent Practitioner (LIP) or in the supervision process of obtaining independent licensure preferred. Clinical training and experience as a therapist required; supervisory experience preferred. Knowledge of and/or ability to learn managed care and private insurance standards, Medicaid standards, accreditation standards, and program specific policies and procedures required. Must be well-organized and able to interact effectively and productively with agency staff, referring agencies, and general public.
