The In-Home Interventionist position will be a key role in a child's life to provide placement stability by providing emotional and behavioral support, as well as crisis management activities and interventions for the child in the foster home. Duties may include, but are not limited to: providing training and clinical supervision of PPTFC foster parents; providing support services and interventions to PPTFC foster parents; completing a variety of client assessment and information gathering tasks for treatment planning; actively participating in treatment team meetings as well as child and family team meetings; administering life skill development activities and interventions with PPTFC clients; providing activities with PPTFC clients to build health coping skills, positive expression of feelings, decision making and problem solving skills, relationship building, and appropriate responses to challenges; and implementing each child's individual plan of care (IPOC). Candidates should have strengths in providing and documenting clinical services, working with other child welfare professionals to meet treatment goals for clients, advocating for children, and providing oral and written reports.

Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited school in the field of behavioral sciences/social services as well as three (3) years documented professional experience in the population to be served.
