Full time, office-based position based out of Columbia, SC, will report to the Director Mental Health Services. The South Carolina Youth Advocate Program (SCYAP) is seeking a positive and dynamic individual to oversee the delivery of high quality, accessible care that supports the mental well being of children and their families in the community. Principal responsibilities include developing and maintaining partnerships with educational entities and obtain contracts to allow SCYAP to provide services in school settings across South Carolina; recruiting, hiring, and training clinical staff to provide services in the school setting; assessing therapists' skill levels to meet client needs so that they are able to provide individual, group, and/or family therapy; providing routine and ongoing clinical and administrative supervision of and consultation with multidisciplinary professionals; reviewing referrals and clinical paperwork; meeting regularly with Director of Mental Health Services and Sr. Director of Community Based Services to communicate information regarding mental health services; developing and utilizing tools to monitor performance metrics, trends, and service demands; ensuring all active cases maintain current and appropriate authorization for services; and ensuring compliance with all company, program, grant, regulatory, certification, and accreditation standards. Will perform other duties as needed.

Minimum qualifications: Masters degree from accredited college or university with a minimum of three (3) years of experience in the area of child welfare or mental health. Knowledge of and/or ability to learn contractual standards, Medicaid standards, accreditation standards, and program specific policies and procedures required. Knowledge or experience working with School Based Mental Health programs or working with the Department of Education or coordinating services with school districts and schools required. Must possess strong organizational, process and people management skills. Salary/benefits; pay dependent on experience and education.
